Revision of Electoral Roll

In advance of the APCM parishes are required or revise or renew their Electoral Roll. This year we will need to revise the roll. You can now do this online via our website by using the button at the bottom of our homepage. This will take you to the online form which you can fill in.

If you are already on the Electoral Roll you do not need to do anything but if you would like to join you can now do this online via the parish website or using the paper copies of the form which are available at the back of church. Forms must be completed by 5th May.

APCM Sunday 19th May after the morning service.

This is an important church meeting and we encourage everyone to attend if you are able. During the meeting we will be electing Wardens and PCC members and there are nomination forms at the back of church which need to be completed prior to the meeting. We will also be electing a new treasurer.

Drainage Works

Following a meeting with our Architects on Thursday 28th March we have agreed all final amendments required by the local council. We have also now appointed a QA who will manage this project and he will begin the process of preparing the bid documentation packs which will then be send to contractors for them to submit their tenders for the work. This process will take 6 months or more to complete so it is unlikely that work will commence until the end of the year at the earliest. In the meantime, we will need to do some serious fundraising

towards the cost of this project in order not to deplete our limited funds. You can donate online using the following link.

The cost of this project will be in excess of £200,000 (exact cost not yet known) All donations will be much appreciated, and anything raised via this route can be used for us to apply for match funding from other organisations.

Following a stream of burglaries in churches in the Twickenham and Richmond Areas over the last year most churches, including All Hallows, are now trying to limit the amount of cash held on the premises.
