### **Revision of Electoral Roll**

# In advance of the APCM parishes are required or revise or renew their Electoral Roll. This year we will need to revise the roll.

If you are already on the Electoral Roll you do not need to do anything but if you would like to join you can now do this online via the parish website. There is a button at the bottom of the home page which will take you directly to the online form. Paper copies of the form will be available for those who cannot do this via the website. Forms must be completed before 5<sup>th</sup> May.

### **Drainage Works**

Following a meeting with our Architects on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> March we have agreed all final amendments required by the local council. We have also now appointed a QA who will manage this project and he will begin the process of preparing the bid documentation packs which will then be send to contractors for them to submit their tenders for the work. This process will take 6 months or more to complete so it is unlikely that work will commence until the end of the year at the earliest.

In the meantime, we will need to do some serious fundraising towards the cost of this project in order not to deplete our limited funds. You can donate online using the following link.

The cost of this project will be in excess of £200,000 (exact cost not yet known)
