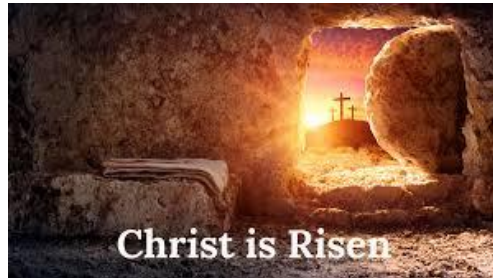

CPR Training

Carol Folly and Joyce Griffiths will be offering a CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation) training session after Mass on Sunday 26th April in the Long Room. First we will watch a video demonstration to see how to administer CPR. Afterwards, for those with mobile phones and access to the internet, there will be the opportunity to try out the method for yourselves. Bring a kneeler from the church. We will also explain how to use a defibrillator, a valuable life-saving device, that we have located outside on the south side of the hall.

Ukraine Relief Fund

Just before Easter, the PCC distributed the money collected for the Ukraine Relief Fund to two worthwhile causes. The first tranche of £338 was donated to UNICEF UK Ukraine Appeal to support their humanitarian work with children. A letter of thanks and a certificate will be displayed at the back of the church.

The second donation was made to the Ukrainian Autocephalous Orthodox Church, London Parish, Cathedral Church of the Holy Transfiguration of Our Lord, based in Acton. UAOC supports Ukrainians who have been displaced both in Ukraine and to the UK and, amongst other services, supplies medical aid to Ukraine. They were grateful for the £338 donation and sent this message:

“We are most grateful that your parish is praying for peace and helping Ukraine during its darkest hour. During this most Holy Week of Easter, Ukrainian families are scattered around the globe seeking refuge from harm, while many others will spend another Easter in the trenches and under threat of bombardment by Russian drones and missiles, our prayers are a comfort to those in harm’s way.

On behalf of our parish, I would like to thank you for your kind donation. We will use the money to produce even more Paskas and Easter baskets for Ukrainian service men and woman, who are here in the UK being trained by His Majesty’s Armed Forces, before being deployed back to defend Ukraine and Europe from Russian aggression. *Volodymyr Muzyczka, Head of Parish Council*”
