Help will be needed to make the Posies on Saturday 14th March.

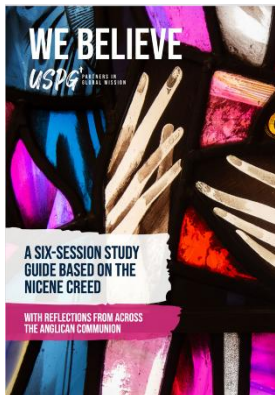
