Groundworks Update

The landscaping between the hall and church is progressing and beginning to take shape. CPR Training

Carol Folly and Joyce Griffiths will be offering a CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation) training session after Mass on Sunday 26th April in the Long Room. First we will watch a presentation and demonstration to see how to administer CPR. We will also explain how to use a defibrillator, a valuable life-saving device, that we have located outside on the south side of the hall. Afterwards, for those with mobile phones and access to the internet, there will be the opportunity to try out the method for yourselves. (Bring a kneeler from the church.)

Ukraine Relief Fund

Just before Easter, the PCC distributed the money collected for the Ukraine Relief Fund to two worthwhile causes. The first tranche of £338 was donated to UNICEF UK Ukraine Appeal to support their humanitarian work with children. A letter of thanks and a certificate will be displayed at the back of the church.

The second donation was made to the Ukrainian Autocephalous Orthodox Church, London Parish, Cathedral Church of the Holy Transfiguration of Our Lord, based in Acton. UAOC supports Ukrainians who have been displaced both in Ukraine and to the UK and, amongst other services, supplies medical aid to Ukraine. They were grateful for the £338 donation.
