### Updates

- **Church Heating** – This has now been serviced and is working. There will be some additional work required to fix the flue and re- do some of the flashing around it at roof level but we are awaiting notification of availability of parts and a date for an engineer to visit.
- **Hall Heating** – This is now working. There was a fault in the connection between the boiler and control panel which was probably caused by someone messing with the override switches in the hall. Additional servicing is being arranged.
- **Cloisters Leak** – This has been inspected and we hope to get a temporary solution in place soon prior to the major work which is required.
- **Hall Development – Groundworks** – Standing Committee have a meeting with the Architects and contractor on 22<sup>nd</sup> Jan when we should be given a revised figure for the costs and material which we can use to do major fundraising efforts.
